Description

Burro's Tail is a popular trailing succulent with long hanging stems covered in plump blue-green leaves. The stems can grow over 60 cm long and create a beautiful cascading effect. It is perfect for hanging baskets, wall planters, balconies, and succulent collections.



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Watering

💧 **Water only when the soil is dry.**

- Summer: Once every 7–10 days
- Winter: Once every 15–20 days
- Avoid overwatering

Temperature

🌡️ **Best Temperature**

- 18°C to 30°C

Can tolerate:

- 8°C to 35°C

Protect from frost and freezing temperatures.

Sunlight

☀️ **Prefers bright light.**

- 4–6 hours of morning sunlight
- Bright indirect light indoors
- Partial sun outdoors

Fertilizer

🌱 **Feed once every month during spring and summer.**

Recommended

- NPK 19:19:19 liquid fertilizer
- Succulent fertilizer
- Seaweed extract

Soil

🌿 **Requires very well-draining soil.**

Simple Soil Mix

- 40% River Sand
- 40% Garden Soil



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Humidity

☁️ Prefers low humidity.

- Ideal humidity: 30%–50%
- Good air circulation is important

Reproduction

🌱 Very easy to propagate.

Leaf Propagation

1. Gently remove a healthy leaf.
2. Let it dry for 1–2 days.
3. Place it on succulent soil.
